**Winning poets will be invited to read at Magma's prize giving event in Spring 2026. The top three placed entries in both competitions will also be published in the magazine.**

Post your poems with the completed entry form together with your payment to **Magma Poetry Competition, 1 Winton Ave, London N11 2AS**. Payment must be made in sterling, by cheque or money order payable to "Magma Poetry".

Each poem must be on a separate sheet. Poems longer than one page must give their title on the second page and the pages should be stapled together. Do not include your name or any other identifying marks on the poems themselves.

The entry fees are **£5 for the first poem, £4 for the second, and £3.50 for the third and each subsequent poem.**

Reduced fees for Magma magazine subscribers: **£4 for the first poem, £3 for the second, and £2.50 for the third and each subsequent poem.** You can subscribe to the magazine with your postal entry by checking the 'Subscribe now' box on the form and adding **£22.00** to your reduced fees amount.
